Submission Deadline: December 1, 2010

The Department of Economics and Community Development at Covenant College will award one merit-based scholarship valued at \$11,000 to one incoming freshman who desires to major in either Economics or Community Development. It can be renewed for three years as long as the student remains in the major and maintains a 3.0 grade point average. In addition, other merit- and financial-need-based award packages ranging from \$4,000 to \$9,500 will be available for qualified candidates.

APPLICANTS MUST COMPLETE SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION SECTIONS I - II ON PAGE 2 AS WELL AS EITHER THE ECONOMICS SUPPLEMENT OR THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT SUPPLEMENT. SPECIFIC REFERENCES ARE REQUIRED IN EACH SUPPLEMENT.

To be considered for an Economics Scholarship you must:

1. Ensure that we receive your completed Scholarship Application form by December 1, 2010 including the TWO completed recommendation forms. At least one recommendation should come from one of your math or science teachers and the other can come from any of the following subjects: English, Math, Social Studies, Foreign Language, or Science—courses in art, music, PE, shop, etc. will **not** be acceptable. Since recommendations are submitted directly to Covenant College, we suggest that you contact your teachers by November 20, 2010 to remind them to submit their recommendations by the deadline.
2. Be accepted for admission to Covenant College. By submitting all admission materials to the College with or before the submission of your scholarship application (due by December 1, 2010), you will ensure that your application for this scholarship will be evaluated.
3. Have a cumulative high school GPA of 3.4 **and** the following standardized test scores:
 - a. SAT score of 1250 (considering critical reading and math only), **and** a math score of at least 650 **or**
 - b. ACT score of at least 26 composite **and** a math score of at least 26.
4. Attend the Scholarship Weekend at the College January 27-29, 2011 *if you are invited as a finalist for this Scholarship*. During the Scholarship Weekend you will be interviewed by faculty members of the Economics & Community Development Department in order to complete your scholarship application process. **Attendance at the scholarship weekend is mandatory.** **Note:** There is an alternate process for overseas applicants.

To be considered for a Community Development Scholarship you must:

1. Ensure that we receive your completed Scholarship Application form by December 1, 2010 including the **TWO** completed recommendation forms. One of the recommendation forms should come from your pastor and one should come from a high school teacher who has taught you in a course in at least one of the following: English, Math, Social Studies, Foreign Language, or Science—courses in art, music, PE, shop, etc. will **not** be acceptable. Since recommendations are submitted directly to Covenant College, we suggest that you contact your pastor and teacher by November 20, 2010 to remind them to submit your recommendation by the deadline.
2. Be accepted for admission to Covenant College. By submitting all admission materials to the college with or before the submission of your scholarship application (due by December 1, 2010), you will ensure that your application for this scholarship will be evaluated.
3. Have a high school GPA of 3.4 and a minimum ACT score of 25 or SAT of 1200 (considering critical reading and math only).
4. Attend the Scholarship Weekend at the college January 27-29, 2011 *if you are invited as a finalist for this Scholarship*. During the Scholarship Weekend you will be interviewed by faculty members of the Community Development Department in order to complete your scholarship application process. **Attendance at the scholarship weekend is mandatory.** **Note:** There is an alternate process for overseas applicants.

NOTE: For either scholarship, if you want to be considered for other financial aid you will need to submit a separate Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).
