To be eligible to apply for the Emerging Artist Scholarship, you must be a **freshman** and have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 **and** 21 ACT **or** 1500 SAT (or 1000 considering critical reading and math only). The Emerging Artist Scholarship is awarded each year to an incoming freshman who intends to major in Art at Covenant College. This merit-based scholarship is valued at \$11,000 and will be renewed for three years as long as the student remains in the major and makes satisfactory academic progress. In addition, other merit and need-based award packages ranging from \$4,000 - \$9,500 may be available for qualified candidates.

Emerging Artist Scholarship Portfolio Requirements

Your portfolio should include images representing your best artwork from high school and consisting of 12-20 works. Digital PowerPoint format is most desirable and should be emailed to admissions@covenant.edu. You may submit your portfolio in the form of photographic prints or slides also. The works should be identified clearly with your name, title of work, media, size, and date completed. Your portfolio should include examples of drawing, and works in two-dimensional or three-dimensional media should be included to demonstrate the depth and breadth of your artistic production. The Art Department welcomes a personal campus visit and portfolio review during which your actual work is reviewed. In any case, we need to have a photographic portfolio to keep for a few weeks while applications are reviewed and scholarship decisions are determined. We will make every attempt to return your materials in a timely manner.

Deadline for submission: The application for admission to Covenant College and art scholarship application should be **received by December 1, 2010**, in order to be considered for an art scholarship. **All finalists must attend the Scholarship Weekend, January 27 - 29, 2011.** **Note:** There is an alternate process for overseas applicants.

For return of portfolio: Please include a self-addressed, stamped envelope for return of your photos. Use a padded postal mailer with sufficient postage and large enough to hold your photos. Portfolios of those not chosen to attend the Scholarship Weekend will be returned in early February. Portfolios of those chosen to attend the Scholarship Weekend will be returned the first week in June. Your self-portrait will remain on file with the Art Department and therefore it will not be returned.
