

Class Reunion Information

We need your help! Curious about what goes into planning these gatherings? Are you interested in helping shape your reunion?

The Alumni Office does much of the planning for Homecoming, but we rely on volunteers to make reunions fun and successful!

Reunions are typically held for these milestones: 50th, 40th, 30th, 25th, 20th, 15th, 10th, 5th, 1st. Reunion gatherings are organized by alumni from each class with help from the Office of Alumni Engagement.

How can you be involved? Volunteers are needed at a variety of levels, from finding a location to hosting, to inviting classmates to attend. Here are some ways you can help:

1. **Host or recommend a local host willing to open up their home or backyard.** Hosts can be alumni, faculty or staff members. Hosting can be a joint effort of several people. Ideally, hosts are not far from campus, so Lookout Mountain and St. Elmo are ideal, but some reunions have been held in Chattanooga, north Georgia, or on campus.
2. **Help invite classmates to attend.** It takes a small group of alumni who are eager and excited to get others to come back for the weekend. A group of 5-10 alumni who are willing to help extend invitations by email or phone makes all the difference!
3. **Help build excitement for the reunion.** Call, text, and email your classmates. Let them know you plan to be there and want to see them! Share memories on social media to remind people of what your time together at Covenant meant to you.
4. **Help with set-up, food or drinks.** Even if you're not hosting, you can offer to help set-up or bring food, drinks, or ice!
5. **Make the reunion and Homecoming weekend your own.** Past volunteers have helped make the reunion weekend even more special by bringing scrapbooks or a slideshow, performing music or hosting a late night gathering.

How will the Alumni Office help with 2018 reunions?

1. Reunions will be during lunch on **Saturday, September 15th, 12:30-2:30.**
2. We will send reunion invitations via email to alumni from reunion classes.
3. We will provide volunteers with a list of alumni to personally invite.
4. We will provide sandwich trays on the day of the event.
5. We will provide Covenant students to lend a hand and help with children.
6. We will provide yard signage to help guests find the gathering.
