

## REPORTING CRIMES & EMERGENCIES / REQUESTING ASSISTANCE

### EOP Section C.2.

The campus community is encouraged to call 911 for any and all life-threatening or serious medical emergencies, or when they witness criminal acts on campus. (The campus is also advised the most direct way to “call 911” is to call the Dade County Emergency Services Department at (706) 657-4111). For all other types of assistance, the campus may contact the Safety and Security Department. All members of the campus community are encouraged to report any and all suspicious behavior, as well as all crimes to their person or property to our department. The College encourages the reporting of all perceived incidents of suspicious or potentially criminal behavior.

Covenant College is located within the police jurisdiction of the Dade County Sheriff’s Office (DCSO). Dade County is situated in Georgia’s extreme Northwest corner and consists of 173 square miles. (The campus does not sit within the city limits or police jurisdiction of the local police department of Lookout Mountain, Georgia.)
